LAKEWOODS LIBRARY CONTRACT


Dear Parent/Guardian;

Students are able to come to the library and independently sign out books to take home and read. Please read the following contract carefully with your child to ensure that you and your child understand the responsibilities involved and will accept the consequences when books are lost or damaged.

The Library has the follow agreement with students:

- I will sign out books carefully at the computer, checking to be sure that my name and --the title of the books are corrected indicated before leaving the library.
- I will sign out my books IN MY NAME ONLY. I will not borrow a library card belonging to someone else.
- I will return books when they are due and I will put them in the correct return bin in the library.
- I will take care of my books and notify the librarian of any damage that occurs.
- If the books I have borrowed are lost or damaged, I agree to pay for the books accordingly to the chart below.
- If I have a library book outstanding, I will not be able to sign out a library book however can enjoy reading in the library.
