



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Immunizations—New Procedures available

Every time your child gets immunized you need to report it to Durham Region Health Department.

For the upcoming school year, an ISPA Reminder letter will be mailed directly to students in late February/Early March. This year, only one ISPA Reminder letter will be provided. Students will **not** be at risk for suspension for overdue immunizations. Parents should follow-up with their healthcare provider when available, as we currently do not have any immunization clinics scheduled at this time. Parents will be able to submit immunization records online at www.durham.ca/immunize. If parents have any questions regarding submitting records online, please call the Immunization program at 905-666-6242.
