

The members of the School Community Council (SCC) invite parents/guardians to join us on **Wednesday February 19**th, from **6-8pm** for our **Technology in Education Information Night**. Our goal is to have open communication with parents about the technologies that we use in our classrooms, and that our students use as a tool for their learning and success.

We are pleased to offer a keynote speaker, 3 breakout sessions and a Q&A period.



One of our breakout sessions will include an introduction to Google Classroom and Google Drive. You will be able to hear from students and staff about this learning platform and experience navigating the virtual classroom.



Our final breakout session includes a discussion on digital citizenship and how students and parents can particpate in

developing positive experiences with the online/digital world. Responsible usage, safety and self-regulation strategies will be the focus of our conversation.



Another breakout session focuses on D2L, or Desire to Learn. This platform is used by some teachers as a tool for learning within their classroom. Additionally, this is the program used for students who choose to enroll in online courses.
