COVID Information—changes effective Feb 23rd

Changes have been made to the mandatory COVID-19 self-screening that must take place every morning before leaving for school. Effective immediately, every student who has <u>one</u> new or worsening symptom of COVID-19 must stay home until:

- They receive a negative COVID-19 test result.
- They receive an alternative diagnosis by a health care professional, or
- It has been 10 days since the start of symptoms, and they are feeling better.
